Grant of recognition to the school from Class Ist to VIII(without aid) with effect from the academic session 1995-97 for a day school.

Sir.

Nith reference to your application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the appropriate authority for grant of recognition in respect of your school from 1st to VIIIth(without aid) with effect from 1935-97 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:

- That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Bules, 1973 and the instructions issued from time to time.
- 2. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff as per the norms of the department. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overageds taff, if any, immediately.
- That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 & 51 of DSER 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provisions of Rules 6,7 & 8 be strictly observed.
- That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per students may be added and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately and more books worth Rn.5000/- be purchased by the start of the next session and the list of books are furnished to the Education Officer for verification.
- 5. Adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
- That the school equip the Science Lab. as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More material worth Rs.5000/- shall be purchased during the current session and a list be furnished to the Education Officer for verification.
- 7. That the school shall edmit students without any discrimination of caste and creed as per the norms of the Deptt.
- The payment shall be made as per provisions of section 10(1) of DSEA 1973 to all employees. The staff should be paid full salary with allowances through cross cheque before 7th of every month.

- The management of the school shall appoint one PET, one T.W.T. and one Drawing teachers within three menths as per RRs of the deptt. and submit the proof to the E.O. concerned. Also the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
- That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund equal to minimum three months salary of the staf in the joint name of the Dy. Director of Education and the Manager of the school w thin three months and submits the proof to the E.O.concerned.
- That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students/teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students immediately.
- 12. Fresh Health Certificate may also be obtained from, MCD within a month and submitted to the E.O. for verification.
- That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated 0 10 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Dte. of Edn., Delhi, in each class. No. of the existing sections should not exceed the number of class rooms of proper size in the school.
- That Govt. nominee in the Managing Committee will be asked immediately and all decisions will be taken in accordance with the provision in the approved scheme of Management by the DDE(ACT).
- The Managing committee of the school shall not enhance the fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of section 17 of Delhi School Edn. Act, 1973 and shall regulate the functioning of the school strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Act and Rules.
- 15. IX class should not be started without the prior approval of the Director of Education.
- That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the deptt. shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
- 17. That a report about the fulfilment of the above zenditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled be sent to the E.O. within six menths.
